Why choose the Microsoft Surface Hub 2S for group collaboration over other digital whiteboards?

Surface Hub 2S is the only digital whiteboard completely engineered by Microsoft. The Surface Hub 2S is an all-in-one device that's even more than a digital whiteboard. Through integrations, content sharing and annotation, and integrations, this device becomes your complete meeting center and projection display.

Designed using a customized version of the Windows 10 OS, it allows for seamless Microsoft Teams, Office 365, and Exchange integration. Team members save time by running any Windows 10 Universal Windows Platform App natively without authenticating or needing any other device in the room.

Sharing content is simple since users can also share any Windows application, including desktop apps such as MS Office from their personal devices directly to the Surface Hub 2S. Users can sign into their OneDrive files to share saved content. Room scheduling is quick and easy, too, since teams can utilize familiar meeting tools, including Outlook, Outlook 365, and Exchange.

How does the Surface Hub 2S empower group collaboration?

The Microsoft Surface Hub 2S digital whiteboard features natural, fluid inking capabilities with virtually no latency, and can detect the difference between a pen and a hand. Following a Teams meeting, attendees can refer to the shared content after the meeting ends. From a security and privacy perspective, the End Session command permanently wipes all activities and data from the Hub's working session.

Meeting participants who prefer to work on personal devices are not excluded from sharing content. Microsoft Surface Hub supports BYOD needs by allowing team members to connect to a meeting and







share content through their laptop or tablet. BYOD is also supported through both wireless content sharing via Miracast from Windows 10 devices, as well as direct-connecting to the Hub's USB-C port.

At the office, add the optional Steelcase Roam™ Mobile Stand and APC™ Charge Mobile Battery to make the Surface Hub 2S completely mobile. Allow your teams to collaborate whenever and wherever inspiration strikes. Hosts can even unplug the device and move it without leaving an ongoing meeting.

How Does the Microsoft Surface Hub 2S Support Collaboration with WFH Remote Workers?

Since the Microsoft Surface Hub 2S was built to support group collaboration, its features ensure that everyone in the meeting room and working from home has a positive user experience and can see and hear all team members in your huddle rooms and small conference rooms. The camera delivers 4K resolution and a 90-degree field of view to deliver crisp images to remote attendees. Integrated speakers and far-field mic arrays assure crystal-clear sound for remote and on-site team members.

To further promote an inclusive meeting experience, remote participants are seen on screen and are not hidden when content is shared. Through Office 365 integration, Surface Hub 2S encourages everyone to collaborate by giving remote team members the same content sharing and annotation capabilities that your on-premises staff has. In larger conference rooms, the device serves as a connected whiteboard that can be positioned next to the main display.
